Japanese brand *Asahi Super Dry* is brewed in Canada by [Molson-Coors](#) for the U.S. market. Rice, corn, and maize are ingredients in all or most of the beers.

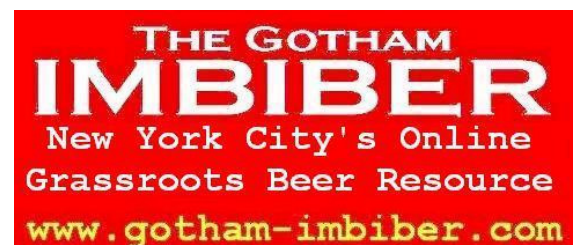
