Lager (4.9%) *** < - MUNICH HELLES - > – Light and clean lager in the Munich Helles style.

Pale Ale (4.6%) *** < - AMERICAN PALE ALE - > – Golden and a little fruity. Hopped with Nelson Sauvin and Pacific Hallertau varieties.

ESB (4.7%) *** < - ENGLISH BEST BITTER - > – English style ale brewed with a proportion of Golden Promise malt.

Black Wattle Superior (5.8%) *** < - HERB, SPICE, OR VEGETABLE BEER - > – Silky dark brown ale with native Australian wattle seed (ground and roasted) added at the end of the boil. Aroma and taste is of nuts and a little chocolate.
