Ratings

Each beer has been given a rating from one to five which should be interpreted as follows.

- * Bland, one-dimensional, or tasting of cheap adjuncts – unenjoyable. Not recommended.
- ** Nothing special but may be worth trying if nothing better is available.
- *** Good, recommended.
- **** Great, highly recommended.
- ***** Exceptionally good, very highly recommended.

Ratings are based on personal taste although, in certain instances, outside evaluations have been used when a particular beer has not been sampled by the author/webmaster.

{S} after the beer name denotes seasonal availability.

Berliner Style Weisse (3.0%) ***** < - BERLINER WEISSE (SOUR) - > – A classic tart Berliner Weisse, fairly soft for the style. Brewed with a ratio of 52% wheat malt and 48% pilsner malt.

Original Leipziger Gose Bier (4.6%) ***** < - SPECIALTY BEER - > (Gose) – Unfiltered wheat beer traditional to Leipzig (but actually originating in Goslar, Lower Saxony), a little spicy with a mild saltiness. Salt, coriander, and a controlled lactic acid infection are added in the brewing process.

Schaffner Naturtrübes Pils (5.0%) ***** < - GERMAN PILSNER - > – Crisp pilsener, golden and clean-drinking with a dry finish.

Kuppler Weisse (5.2%) ***** < - GERMAN WEISSBIER / HEFEWEIZEN - > – Cloudy, dark orange hefeweizen with notes of yeast, banana, coriander, and cloves, plus there's a slight tartness.

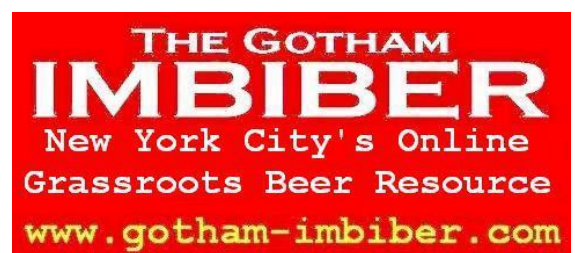
Heizer Schwarzbier (5.3%) ***** < - SCHWARZBIER - > – A black beer, malty with intense flavors of coffee with a little burnt and roast character.
