La Moneuse (8.0%) ***** < - SAISON - > – Golden orange, lively saison that tastes of herbs and spices.

La Moneuse Special Winter {S} (8.0%) ***** < - BELGIAN GOLDEN STRONG ALE - > – Aged version, spicy and tangy.
