### **CASK ALE [H]**

41 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue (between East 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Streets).  
Tel: 1 212 475 5097.

A superb range of unusual beers (ever-changing), including cask ales, can be found here. Whenever British cask imports are available, this is the most reliable place to find them. No food (except cheese plates on Mondays), though it is ok to bring your own in. There's an option of imperial pints for an extra \$1. Check out their website to see the place on a live webcam. A sister pub operates in New Orleans, and there's a branch over the river in Brooklyn (q.v.). There is a beer garden at the back. Bus M15 from over the road takes you a block away from The Waterfront Ale House (Manhattan), The Stag's Head, and David Copperfield's. ID is required for entry most evenings. Opens at 1pm daily. Free WiFi.

Subway: 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue **FV** - exit from the 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue end.

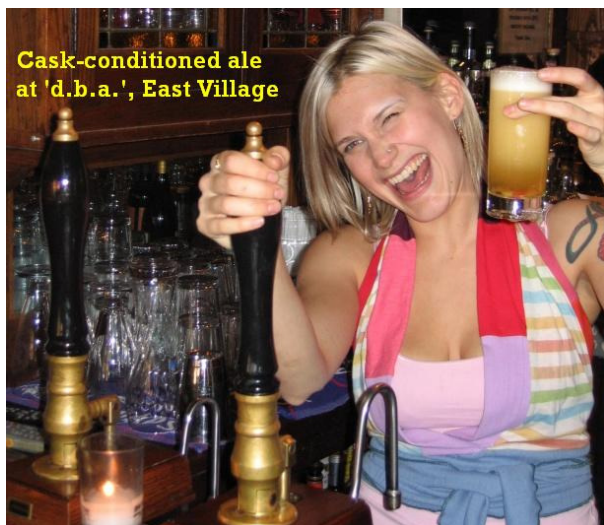
