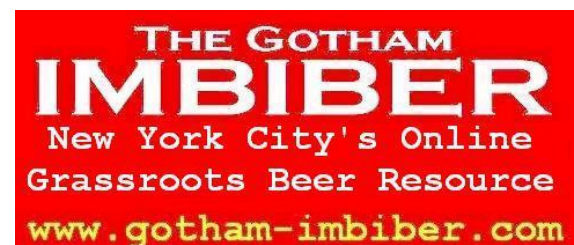
Crimson Voodoo (5.0% estimated) ** < - AMBER LAGER / RED LAGER - >
