A cask pump and twenty mainly craft beers are on tap, but the main attraction is what is believed to be the widest bottle selection of any bar in the city – about 700, including some very rare (but not cheap) vintages of beers that have been cellared. It is run by the people who used to have the Happy Deli, which used to be the major oasis for take-home beer in the Times Square area until being ousted for a new condo development. A major beer destination, and very close to The Brazen Head, Waterfront, and Atlantic Chip Shop which makes for an easy crawl.
