Ratings

*** Good, recommended.

**** Great, highly recommended.

***** Exceptionally good, very highly recommended.

Ratings are based on personal taste although, in certain instances, outside evaluations have been used when a particular beer has not been sampled by the author/webmaster.

{S} after the beer name denotes seasonal availability.

Avril (3.5%) **** < - SAISON - > – An organic, light bodied table beer, spicy and bready.

Saison Dupont (6.5%) ***** < - SAISON - > – An outstanding, earthy, spritzy, orange-amber saison.

Foret (aka Moinette Biologique) (7.5%) **** < - SAISON - > – Orange-gold organic ale with spices and an earthy texture.

Bière de Miel Biologique (8.0%) **** < - SAISON - > – Sweet and floral with honey and coriander coming through.

Moinette Belgian Ale (8.5%) **** < - BELGIAN GOLDEN STRONG ALE - > – Satisfying golden beer with grassy hops and a moderate yeastiness.

Moinette Brune (8.5%) **** < - BELGIAN DARK STRONG ALE - > – Dark brown with sweet malt and dark fruit notes.

Avec Les Bons Vieux {S} (9.5%) ***** < - SAISON - > – A rustic, earthy winter brew with spicy hop character.

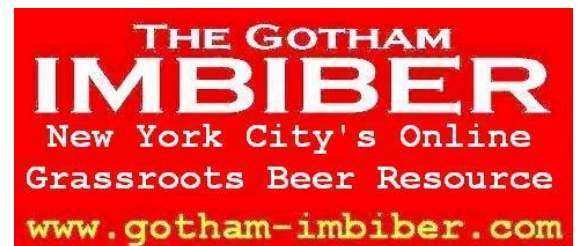
