STRAWBERRY BLONDES - Incendiary young hard-gigging South Wales punks, currently making huge waves with their debut album 'Rise Up'. Great lyrics, great tunes, Rancid to their Clashy core...

TV SMITH - Former Adverts/Explorers legend, now a wonderful solo singer/songwriter.

SWILL & THE SWAGGERBAND - The Men They Couldn't Hang frontman with his showcase band, featuring TMTCH members past and present.

AL BAKER & ALUN PARRY - Two fine political songwriters from the North West.

Saturday 5th July, Noon - Midnight (£10):

BLYTH POWER - A very rare gig from visionary balladeering trainspotter Joseph and his cohorts.

PPZ-30 - Brussels-based funk-punk-jazz combo, hugely original - think Chilli Peppers meets Funkadelic!

THE MEOW MEOWS - Dance to your local ska orchestra!

CONTINGENT - Fiery Stoogeseque punks from Brussels, Attila played bass with them in 1979, reformed after 28 years!

LUKE WRIGHT - Fast-rising star of the performance poetry scene, formerly of Aisle 16 who previously stormed Glastonwick.

EASTFIELD - Named after a railway depot in Glasgow. Still don't like Port Talbot Transport Police.

STEVE DREWETT - Singer of the seminal Newtown Neurotics with a rare solo set.

ROBB JOHNSON AND THE IRREGULARS - Brilliant political songwriter and Brentford fan with his band.

WOB (with full band) - Bouncing melodic happy ball of energy (except when he does the one about ethnic cleansing).

BABAR LUCK - Frankenstane-Anglo-Pakistani-Muslim rapper/folkiepunk, former frontman of King Prawn.
