B.B. Burgerbrau (aka 1795 Original) (4.7%) *** < - BOHEMIAN PILSNER - > – Crisp, grassy Czech pilsener.

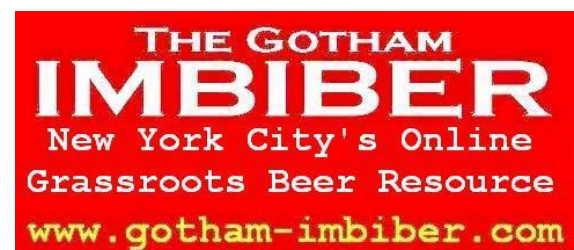
