{S} after the beer name denotes seasonal availability.

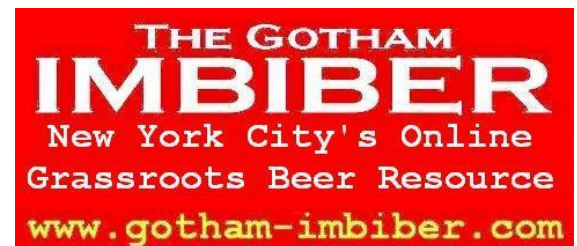
