***** Exceptionally good, very highly recommended.

Ratings are based on personal taste although, in certain instances, outside evaluations have been used when a particular beer has not been sampled by the author/webmaster.

{S} after the beer name denotes seasonal availability.

Neuzeller Schwarzer Abt (aka Black Abbot) (3.9%) ** < - SCHWARZBIER - > – Disappointing black beer brewed with invert sugar syrup.

Neuzeller Original Badebier (aka Original Bathbeer) (5.2%) *** < - SCHWARZBIER - > – Very dark but not quite black. Smooth on the palate, the predominant flavor is malt with some roast and caramel notes. Too good for putting in your bathwater as the bottle frivolously suggests, my suggestion is to do that with a mass-produced light lager instead.

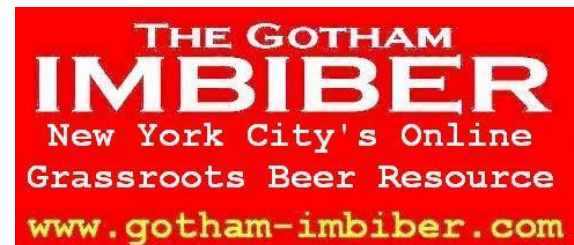
Neuzeller Kloster Zell (aka Golden Abbot) (6.3%) *** < - DORTMUNDER EXPORT LAGER - > – Amber lager with plenty of malt sweetness.
