Goolman (5.0%) * * < - BOHEMIAN PILSNER - > – A crisp but straightforward pilsner.

Goolman Original Gold (6.0%) * * * < - STANDARD LAGER - > – Mild lager, a little sweet.

Perła Chmielowa Pils (6.2%) * * * < - BOHEMIAN PILSNER - > – A strong pilsner with a delicate bitterness. The name translates as 'Hop Pearl'.

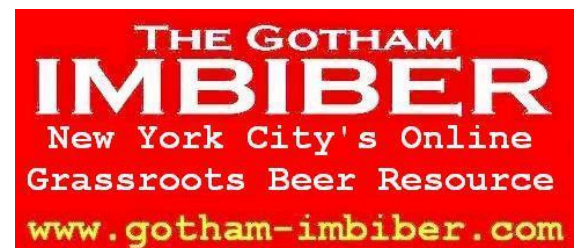
Perła Mocna (7.6%) * * * < - PREMIUM LAGER - > – Orange-amber lager with high carbonation and alcohol notes on the palate.
