Joseph (5.0%) *** < - SPECIALTY BEER - > – A golden witbier variant brewed with spelt (a member of the wheat family), wheaty with citrus and spice notes.

Sara (6.0%) *** < - HERB, SPICE, OR VEGETABLE BEER - > – Dark reddish-brown beer brewed with organic buckwheat, a little spicy with a hint of sourness.
