Huisbrouwerij Sint Canarus is situated in the tiny village of Gottem, just south of the small East Flanders town of Deinze. It is a small craft brewery serving a small, rural community. Brewmaster Piet Meirhaeghe is also known as Dr. Canarus, the brewery & brewmaster get their name from a local drinking club, called Semper Canarus (translation - always drunk). The doctor goes as far as hosting group lectures at the brewery about the positive health benefits of alcohol..

{S} after the beer name denotes seasonal availability.

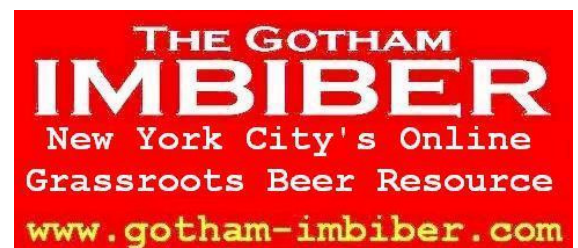
Potteloereke (8.0%) ***** < - BELGIAN DARK STRONG ALE - > – Dark mahogany ale with a nose of ripe fruit and roasted malt. Plum, raisin, caramelized sugar, and some luscious sweet malt on the palate makes this a pleasure to drink. Highly carbonated.

Tripel (7.5%) ***** < - BELGIAN TRIPEL - > – Orange-amber, spicy tripel with mango and grapefruit notes and a dry finish.
