St. Peter's Bungay, U.K. (England)

Beer in distinctive green 'medicine' bottles is this brewery's marketing niche, interestingly these are a copy of a design produced circa 1770 for a Pennsylvania innkeeper. However, round bottles of St. Peter's beers are now appearing on the market. St. Peter's was founded in 1996 on the estate of St. Peter's Hall in eastern England.

Ratings

Each beer has been given a rating from one to five which should be interpreted as follows.

* Bland, one-dimensional, or tasting of cheap adjuncts – unenjoyable. Not recommended.

** Nothing special but may be worth trying if nothing better is available.

*** Good, recommended.

**** Great, highly recommended.

***** Exceptionally good, very highly recommended.

Ratings are based on personal taste although, in certain instances, outside evaluations have been used when a particular beer has not been sampled by the author/webmaster.

{S} after the beer name denotes seasonal availability.

English Ale (aka Organic Ale) (4.5%) *** < - ENGLISH BEST BITTER - > – Orange-amber organic beer brewed with malt from Scotland and organic Target hops. Quite delicate, well-balanced and refreshing.

Golden Ale (4.7%) *** < - BLONDE ALE - > – Light-bodied, refreshing beer a little similar to a Czech pilsener. Brewed with English Halcyon malt and lager malts, Goldings hops provide the bitterness and aroma.

India Pale Ale (4.9%) *** < - ENGLISH PALE ALE - > – Golden copper colored, light-to-medium-bodied beer brewed with malt grown locally to the brewery, and hopped with First Gold. Not really an authentic IPA.

Old-Style Porter (5.1%) **** < - BROWN PORTER - > – Dark and complex with notes of caramel and coffee. Created the traditional way for a porter by blending freshly brewed and aged batches.

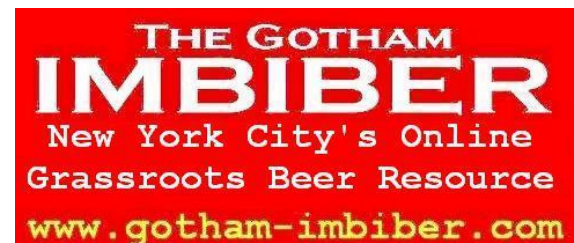
Cream Stout (6.5%) ***** < - SWEET STOUT / MILK STOUT - > – Black and creamy with a mild roastiness. Brewed with Fuggles and Challenger hops.
