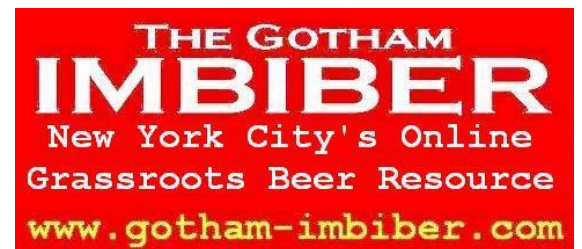
**Frankenheim Alt** (4.8%) \*\*\*\*\* < - ALTBIER / STICKE - > – Dark copper altbier with caramel notes.
