Staten Island finally has a serious multi-tap beer bar with the opening of The Wild Goose in October 2009 in the Irish-rooted West New Brighton locality. Most of the 32 taps are craft offerings, and there is a gravity cask usually available. The bottle menu includes at least 35 craft brews, both domestic and imported. Opening hours are noon to 4am daily. Note the Beer Advocate and Ratebeer scores on the blackboard. Buses S48 and S98 go here from St. George ferry terminal (alight at the Bard Avenue stop), and the S46 and S96 take you a few minutes walk away to Castleton Avenue and Bard Avenue. Also, outbound only weekday late afternoons, you can catch express buses X16 and X30 from Manhattan.

Staten Island Railway: Stapleton – 1½ miles.
