Boss Beer (8.1%) *** < - PREMIUM LAGER - > – A well-balanced strong lager.

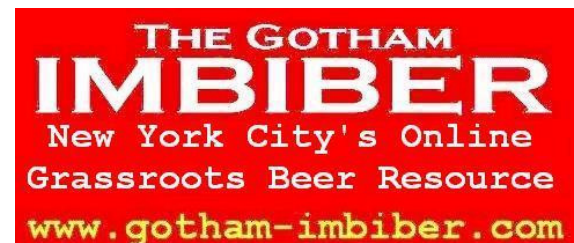
