Light Lager (2.7%) ** < - LIGHT LAGER - >

Light Beer (3.1%) ** < - LIGHT LAGER - >

Premium Beer (4.5% estimated) ** < - STANDARD LAGER - >

Black and Tan (4.7% estimated) *** (blend of more than one beer) – Brewery packaged mix of Porter and Premium Beer.

Traditional Lager (4.9%) *** < - AMBER LAGER / RED LAGER - > – Amber lager, refreshing and easy on the palate. Undemanding but decent.

Lord Chesterfield Ale (5.0% estimated) ** < - AMERICAN PALE ALE - >

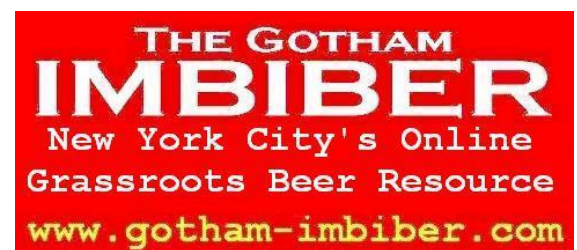
Porter (5.0% estimated) *** < - ROBUST PORTER - > – A fairly thin, dark porter with a little bitterness.
